

By Bus

The nearest bus stop is on Kingston Hill (Albert Arms) for 57, 85, 213, KU1, KU3, and N213 and on Park Road for 371.

By Train

The nearest station is Norbiton, which is a 12 minute walk. The station provides connections from London Waterloo (28 minutes) to a number of stations in South West London including Wimbledon (10 minutes), Twickenham (20 minutes), Richmond (26 minutes) and Clapham Junction (18 minutes).

By Bike

There are various cycle routes in the area including Queens Road, Richmond Park Tamsin Trail, Tudor Road, Elm Road and Kingston Hill. There is cycle parking provided for a number of cycles. Cycle journey planning can be found at www.tfl.gov.uk/cycles.

By Foot

The walking environment is generally very pleasant with roads paved to a good standard.

Kingston town centre is a 20 minute walk away and a journey planner is available at www.walkit.com.

By Car

There are local car clubs available with bays in Park Road and details can be found at www.carclubs.org.uk.

A Controlled Parking Zone operates around the church Monday to Saturday and tickets may be purchased from nearby machines. Hours vary from street to street.
