I sent a link to an Iranian evangelistic film, 'More than Dreams', to all my Farsi speaking friends and encouraged them to share the link with their friends and family members. I received over a hundred encouraging responses saying they had shared the link or had enjoyed the film. Here are a few of the responses; "Thank you for this great video. It's very impressive and I sent it to my Iranian friends." "Wow, amazing, thanks very much." "Thanks so much, I will share it." "I've introduced Jesus to my family in Iran and I'm trying to find the best way to do that. I have a younger sister who is very interested about Jesus. I'll send it to her." "I hadn't seen that, that was fantastic." "Thank you, I will definitely share it." "It was amazing, I should watch it over and over and be hopeful that the Holy Spirit reach into my life." Pray for it to go viral, especially in Iran.

Through the above, I've reconnected with two families who I've not been in touch with for years to find them both going on with the Lord. One family, that I'd written off spiritually, wrote, "Now I understand how much God loves me and my family. I am sure about his plans for me." He wrote inviting me to share at the online Farsi Bible study of the church he now attends where he is the acting pastor for the Farsi speakers. Fortunately we have a God who never gives up on us!

Our Tuesday and Friday night online Farsi group is growing. I've just added 6 new arrivals plus two in Halifax. Pray for effective evangelism and discipleship.

Here is a text conversation from this morning: Paul wrote: "Would you say that you and your wife have a relationship with Jesus? Would you say you know his presence in your life?" Reply: "We are very happy to meet you at your church. We would love to have Jesus Christ in our lives."

Another British couple will join our NW Birmingham ministry in July which will make us 45 members nationwide, (up from 34 in Feb 17), working in 14 UK cities.

Sarah has finished her degree in Glasgow and is now home with us, but we still can't make plans for her wedding until international travel becomes more definite. Sarah has been accepted for an MA counselling course at Moody Bible Institute in Chicago where Binay is presently seeing riots and curfew!
